

- All active NAWGJ members are invited
- Compulsory testing:
 - All online
 - Begins August 1
 - Priorities for assigning compulsory meets in the fall of 2021 through December 31:
 - First priority goes to those who have PASSED the 2021-29 Level 4/5 exam
 - Next priority is for those who have tested but did not pass.
 - Last to be assigned are those who have a 2013-21 Level 4/5 rating, but have not yet taken the 2021-29 exam.
 - Anyone who has a current Level 4/5 rating (2013-21) and has not passed the 2021-29 exam by December 31, 2021 will no longer be eligible to judge Levels 1-5.
- Optional testing:
 - July TBD in DFW
 - September 5 at GAT in Austin
 - Look out for other potential optional tests in Texas at https://usagym.org/pages/women/pages/judging_accreditation.html#
 - Effective August 1, 2022, all written exams will be online, but the practical exams will continue to be administered in a live, person-to-person exam
