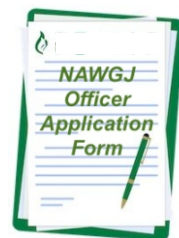

What happens when I do not display professionalism as a judge in the gymnastics arena?

Action: I failed to arrive at the meet on time

Consequence: the meet director requests that I not be assigned to judge their meets in the future.

Action: I show favoritism to one particular team when judging by giving them higher scores

Consequence: I lose respect from coaches and athletes

Action: I voice my opinion about how I thought that another judging panel gave the wrong scores

Consequence: I lose respect from my fellow judges

Action: I use social media to express my disappointment in not getting a particular assignment

Consequence: remember social media posts last forever and acting on my emotions may cause me to regret my decision later.

Action: I arrive at the meet and see some coaches on the floor who I have not seen in a long time and offer hello hugs and start chatting to catch-up just before the meet starts

Consequence: This might appear to others that I am inherently biased towards those individuals perhaps giving their athletes higher scores!

Please keep in mind that perception is reality to others and even though you may have good intentions, out of context any of these actions could jeopardize your reputation as a judge!
